



4th edition of European Code Against Cancer launched

The Code consists of 12 recommendations to reduce cancer risk, and ways to adopt healthier lifestyles across Europe. This edition includes e.g. vaccination against human papillomavirus and limiting the use of hormone replacement therapy. The new Code was launched on 14 October by IARC and WHO.
